Job Summary	
<p>The job post holder will be primarily as a railway operative and rolling stock fitter on all associated railways. This includes the day-to-day maintenance of locomotives, passenger stock, and freight stock. During times when the railways are operating, there could be a need to work on various roles on the operating railway such as Driver, Fireman, Guard, Signaller and Duty Officer and training will be provided for various aspects of this role.</p> <p>On average the working hours will be 40 hours per week, dependant on company requirements and events but usually Weds-Sun.</p> <p>This role requires a great 'people person' with a passion for railways, who is prepared to work flexibly and is just as comfortable in a customer-facing role as they are with the day-to-day maintenance of the locomotives.</p>

<p><u>Rolling Stock Maintenance</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Undertake boiler washouts. • Maintain and repair boiler fittings. • Undertake routine servicing and repairs of diesel/petrol locomotive engines. • Maintain accurate records. • Progress to undertaking periodic/annual fitness to run examinations. • Undertake basic welding and fabrication work. • Undertake basic woodwork as required for seats/doors etc. <p><u>Railway Operations</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To be responsible (after required training and qualification) for the safe operation of locomotives on all railways. <p><u>General</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work in accordance with Safe Systems of Work and other policies and instructions that may be issued from time to time. • Be a good team player and willing to be flexible to work within the operational requirements of the business. • Be able to work well independently as well as on your own. Have a positive, can-do approach to work. • Maintain good working relationships with colleagues and maintain confidentiality as appropriate. • Attend training courses to gain, retain and enhance knowledge. • Other duties • From time to time, assist with other tasks and duties as reasonably requested including participation in permanent way tasks.
